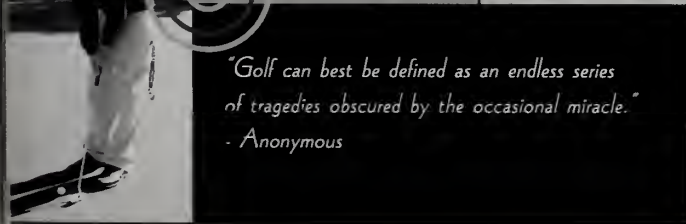


## A Message from the Captains:
