TROOP COMMITTEES

Because of the significance of the Girl Scouts as a community organization, Scout Troops should have the guidance of adult members of the community. The necessary linking of the Scouts to the community may be effected by Local Councils, or Troop Committees, or both. Where there is even one Troop of Girl Scouts, there may be a Troop Committee consisting of from three to eight members, carrying out the functions designated in the National Constitution. In large centers the working of the Local Council may be delegated to Troop Committees in various districts. Troop Committees will always be responsible to the Local Council where both exist. (See Blue Book of Rules, II-4 D.) Where there are to be more than three troops, it is recommended that a Local Council be formed.

Fee: One dollar annually per member. Cards will be sent to each member on receipt of the fee.

Orders: Orders for equipment must be signed by the registered Captain or Lieutenant. The Troop Committee has nothing to do with orders.
