A VICTORY TO REMEMBER FOR MAYNARD

The 1991 Thanksgiving Day football game was a game full of emotion. The seniors felt sad, excited, and confused. The game was an intense one.

In spite of a late rally by Nashoba, the Tigers outscored them by a touchdown. Senior Jeff LeBlanc was responsible for two touchdowns and sophomore Jarreau DeLeon for one. LeBlanc kicked two out of three extra points for Maynard's 20-13 victory. Peter Lombardo and Jeff LeBlanc received MVP honors for the game. Joey Crail had his best game in four years at starting quarterback. He threw for 230 yards, had two touchdown passes and broke the MHS record for passing in one season with 1,300 yards.

Even though they didn't get the chance to play in a Super Bowl, the '92 team has the best record ever recorded in Maynard High history. They also brought back the league title which had not been won by Maynard since 1938.

The major goal on the field

was to win and to be a part of M.H.S. history. That goal was reached and will be remembered in the years to come.

The Thanksgiving game of 1991 was tough on the players, fans and past players of M.H.S. football. It was the last game coach Ed Mullin would coach. Coach Mullin has held that title since 1985. In his years of coaching, he led the 1986 team to the Super Bowl, with an 8-2 record. This year the Tigers were 10-1 but didn't get a Super Bowl berth. He has helped many young men grow both on and off the field. To the players, Coach Mullin has been a mentor and a teacher. To Coach Ed Mullin, a fond farewell; you will be missed greatly on the sidelines of Alumni Field.

Captains Dan Kalafatas and Mike Ferguson felt the game was the end of an era as well as the end of their football careers. Senior Joey Crail felt very emotional following the game after realizing he might just have played in the last football game of

his life. Pete Lombardo's emotions were mixed going into the game, he felt excited and nervous to play in front of so many people. Most seniors felt depressed since they were ending their competitive careers and would miss their teammates and coaches. The feelings that warm day in November, were more than words can communicate.

To the seniors, Dan, Mike, Joey, Jeff, Pete, Jaime, Daryl, Scott, Ted, Dave, Rob, Jay, Rich, Steve, Chad and the rest of the 1991 football team, as well as the coaches, congratulations on an outstanding season.

Maynard High School's annual Spirit Week and football rally was another great success in 1992.

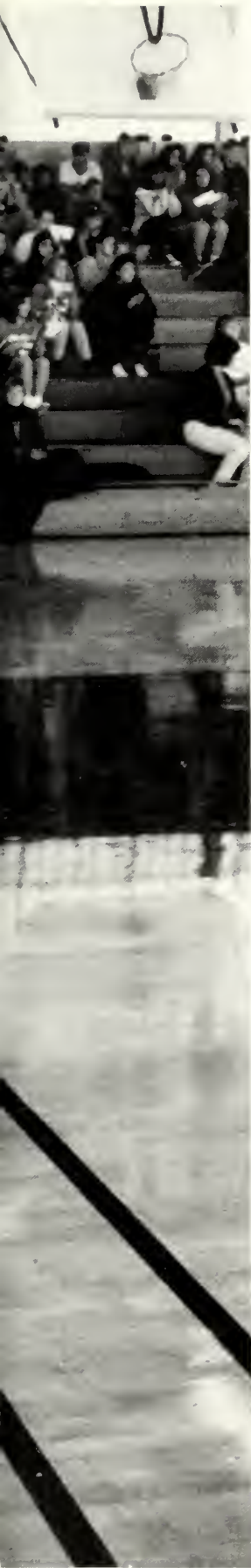
