Judy Wing

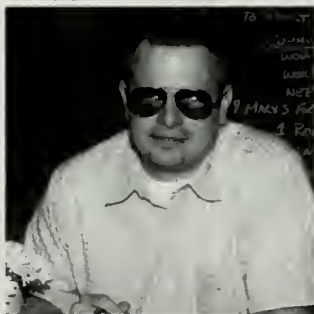

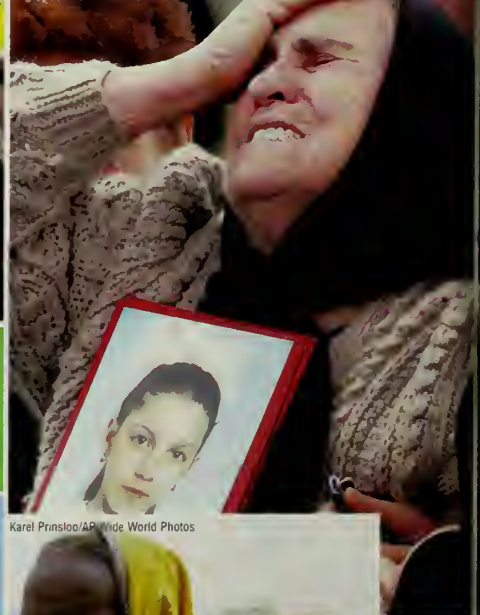

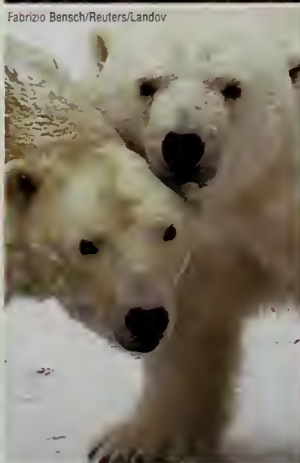
