WORDS TO REMEMBER — JOHN HENRY CARDINAL NEWMAN

God has created me to do Him some definite service; He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission — I never may know it in this life, but I shall be told in the next . . . I have a part in a great work.

One secret act of self-denial, one sacrifice of inclination to duty, is worth all the mere good thoughts, warm feelings, passionate prayers in which idle people indulge themselves.

In a higher world it is otherwise; but here below to live is to change; and to be perfect is to have changed often.

OPLATEK

Every nation glories in its culture. The cultures of peoples are best reflected in their traditions. The nobler the culture, the more significant and spiritually meaningful the traditions.

Poland has a right to be proud of her history. She has etched an enviable position among nations. Her historical record reveals one characteristic feature. Poland has always been a religious country. Government and religion has always been closely intertwined. Roman Catholicism has been ever the breath of the Polish people.

As a result, the Polish people have many beautiful traditions, inspiring and meaningful. At this coming Season commemorating Christ's Birth, we take note of one such tradition: The Oplatek.

The Oplatek involves a very simple ceremony, and yet held dear by the young and old, the poor and the rich. At the Vigil of Christmas — the family gathers at table to partake of a most sumptuously prepared meal. But, before the meal begins, all members arise — the head of the house distributes among all a white wafer of unleavened bread. And, then, from the head of the family to the youngest member, there is the ceremony of mutual breaking and exchange of the unleavened bread. At the same time, words of good will are exchanged. Where necessary, those in strife are reconciled. Thus, religiously fortified, they all sit down together to eat of the things that God has given them. An atmosphere of gaiety and joy and exuberance prevails; for, the whole ceremony is in honor of the Birth of Christ the King — and the participants, dedicated members of His household.

May the Spirit of the Oplatek pervade every home and every heart here in Maynard. It will show our appreciation and our regard for the spirit of our ancestors. It will show that, even though we are citizens of a new land, which we love most dearly, we realize how much the "Old Country" has contributed to our personal development. Without such a heritage, we would not have much to offer for the preservation and betterment of our America. It will also tend to help us appreciate more the religious character of Christmas. It may help to deepen our very Faith. If so, our lives will be richer and happier.

THE MILLENNIUM AND THE SECOND VATICAN COUNCIL

In Rome Cardinal Wyszynski called two meetings of the Bishops from Poland and the United States, at which was discussed the spiritual and political situation in Poland. Also reviewed were plans for the celebration of the millennium in Poland and outside of Poland.

- 1.) "Although we are scattered, we are everywhere one in the Faith. Just as you who live in Rome feel secure because you live here in the fatherland of our Faith, so we feel secure with you here in Rome, one in Grace, under a common Father, the Pope, the successor of Peter, John XXIII. Together then we embark in a Great Novena to celebrate Poland's birth in Christianity."
- 2.) It was agreed to secure, within the limitations of human effort, the success of this manifestation of our Faith; for Poland, that she persevere despite the yoke of atheistic Communism, but for all of us, one in the Mystical Body, the attainment, through Grace, of everlasting conformity to the will of God.

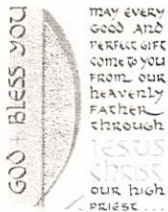

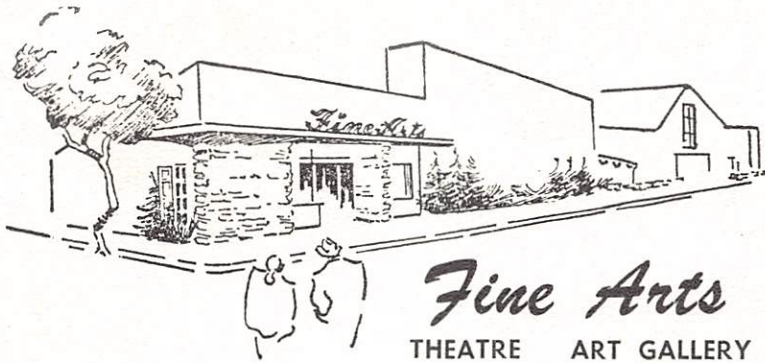
