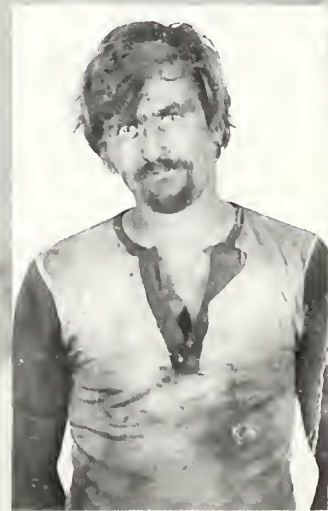
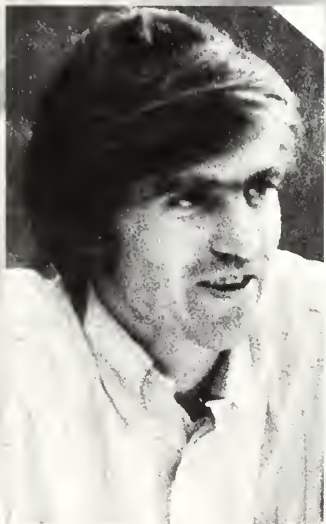
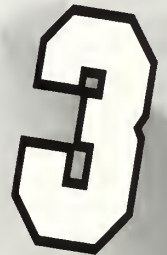


MHS: 1965-2003

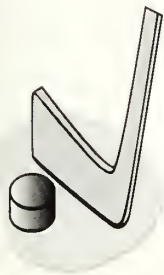
Coaches Message

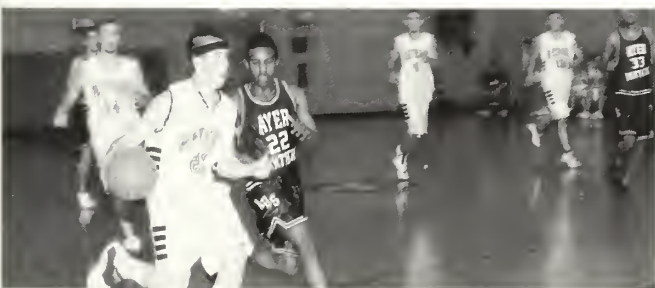
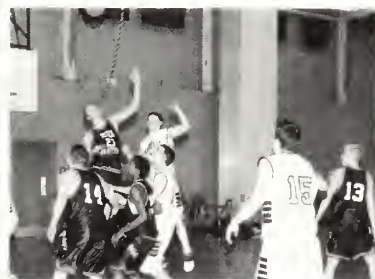
Coaches Message

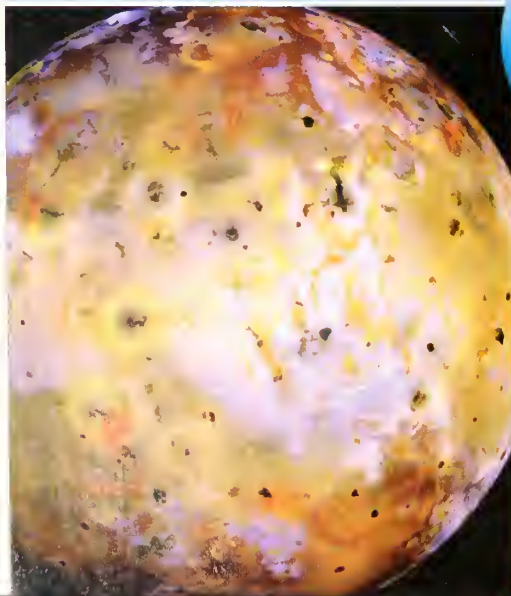

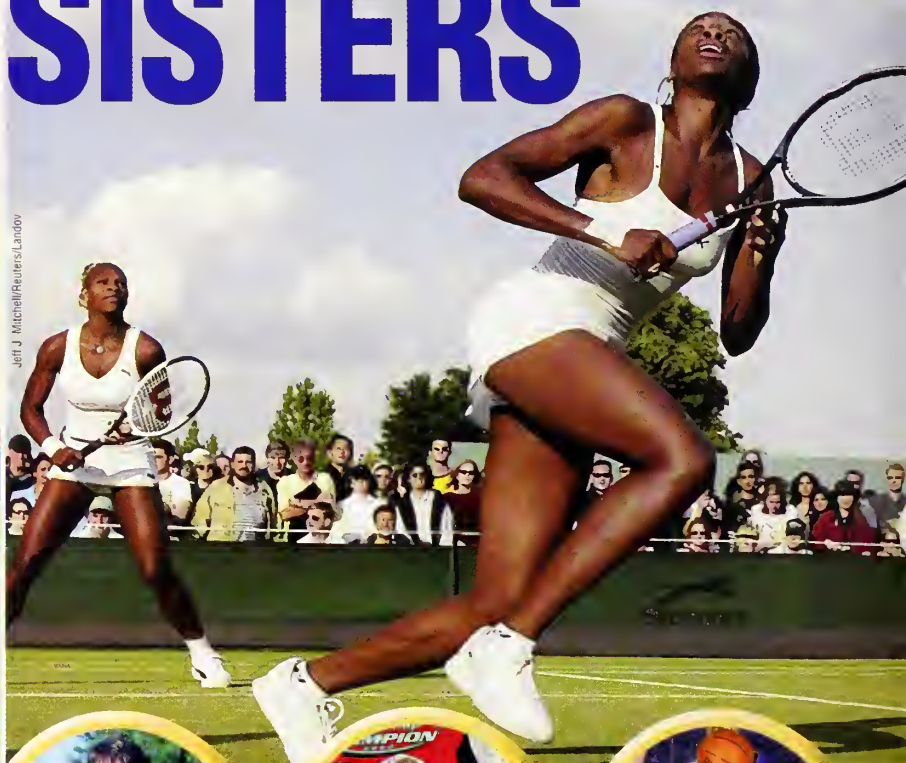

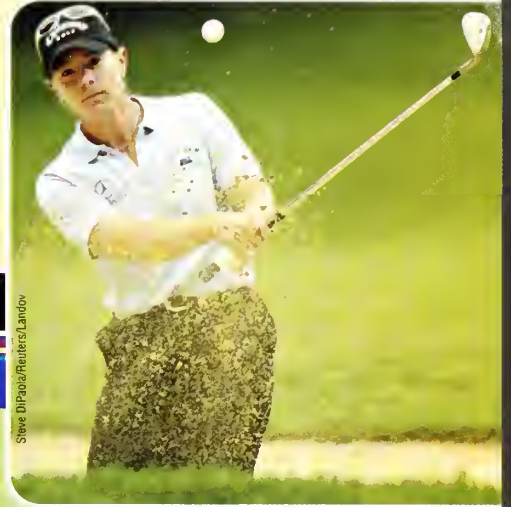
