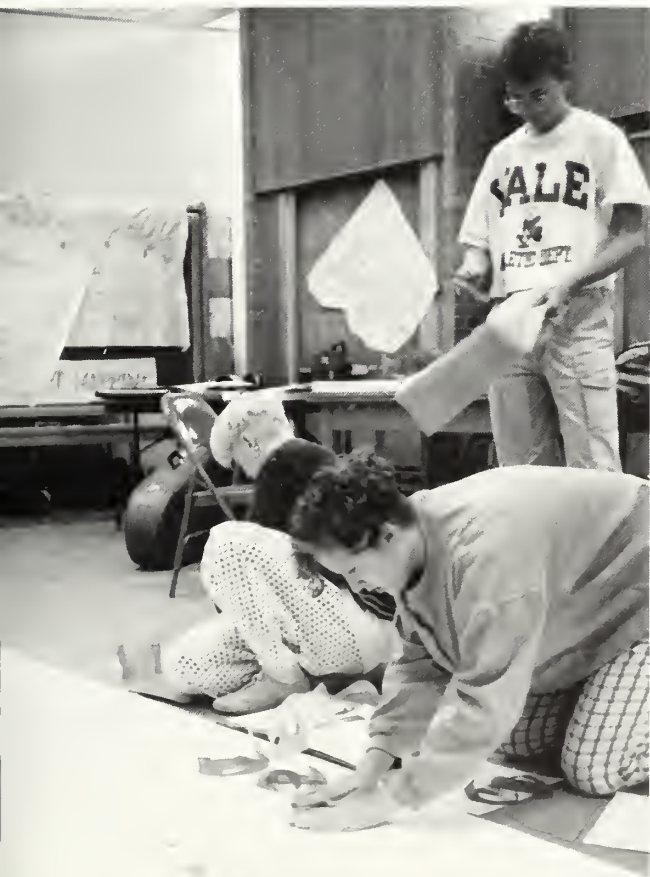
## Writing, Seeing and Listening

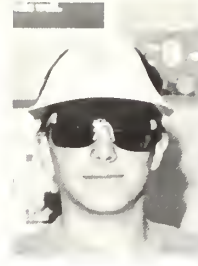
