




POLICE NEED PUBLIC SUPPORT

The daily contributions the Policeman makes toward preserving the law and insuring domestic tranquility often are overlooked. The decade of the 60's and now the '70's have been particularly tough for the policeman.

He has been told that Law enforcement must be infused with a new spirit, a spirit of awareness of our society and its demands; a spirit of responsiveness to those demands being placed upon law enforcement; a spirit of progressiveness to those determined to be abreast, if not ahead of the times - rather than being several steps behind; a spirit of innovation to attempt the unproven, the "unheard of" in the face of the opposition.

He is criticized for being too forceful in containing angry mobs, or for being too lenient. Forgotten, however is the element of danger a policeman lives with daily.

He has to learn new procedures and techniques in response to court decisions aimed at greater protection for the rights of individuals accused of crimes.

Amid public demand for more protection from crimes in the streets, he is aware of a reluctance by the public to become involved in Police matters. Especially the public's lack of support to provide the means required by the Police to accomplish the goals placed on them.

He must accept social experimentation from courts and parole boards even as he is shocked at the number of second and third offenders he must arrest, especially among offenders under 20.

He is told to strive for professionalism, to seek education and training to improve his abilities to perform the multitude of skills required of today's police officers. Yet incentives for attracting highly-qualified recruits are limited. Educational requirements are lowered. Promotions come slowly. Every struggle for a pay increase seems to hurt his public image.

But probably, the thing that hurts the most is the diminishing respect by the public, especially young people, that comes when he puts on a badge. Perhaps this comes about because he generally doesn't understand the need to tell his own story in the face of complaints of inefficiency, brutality, laziness and avarice that are circulated widely by all news media.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF MAYNARD

Five years before Custer met up with too many Indians at the Battle of the Little Big Horn in Montana, the town of Maynard was incorporated.

Although this makes the town a relative newcomer to the state Maynard is still one of the older communities in the country.


The History of the Maynard area begins with the colonization of Massachusetts. Maynard was previously known as Assabet Village, for the river that flows through the town. This area was originally Indian land which had been incorporated into the towns of Stow and Sudbury.

Because of the river, and the development of water-power as a means of operating early manufacturing machinery, particularly textiles, the community became one of the early industrial areas of the Commonwealth.

EARLIEST SETTLERS

The earliest settlers of the Sudbury-Stow region came from England on the ship "Confidence" in 1638. Governor Winthrop signed signed the three deeds which registered the purchase of the lands from the Indians by the Colonists

The third of these grants, made in 1649, was known as the "two mile" grant, for which a price of about \$60 was paid. Part of these lands may have been a tract called the "Taltamous Transfer" in which a Blacksmith, Herman Garrett of Concord foreclosed a mortgage on a mare and colt sold by him to the Indian Taltamous, who thereby surrendered about 1000 acres of land. It is this part of the granted lands that apparently contained the present location of Maynard.




OTHER COMMUNITIES

ASSABET VILLAGE

The area now known as Maynard was for years known as Assabet Village, named for the river that runs through the town. Amory Maynard was one of that early breed of New England entrepreneurs who recognized the value of water-power and was familiar enough with the technology of the day to know how to use it. He began acquiring property in the area starting in 1828.

The land in the region was excellent for farming, and agriculture was the main occupation. The acreage of the farms was relatively large, and the number of farms small. Old Stone walls can still be found in the community, marking the boundaries of the one-time farmlands.

KING PHILLIP'S WAR

The Indian uprising known as "King Phillip's War" and called by some residents "King Phillip's Invasion", depending on who could be regarded as invading who, was a difficult period for residents of the region. The Summer Hill area, where the Maynard Reservoir is located is said to have been the scene of an Indian pow-wow, where the decision was reached as to whether the Indians should attack Concord or Sudbury. Sudbury lost, and in the battle which followed, most of the inhabitants of the Maynard region were slaughtered.

Many Indian relics have been found on the farm of Lucius H. Maynard, one of Amory's sons. Amory purchased the farm in 1828, and his two sons, Lucius and George managed the farm for many years.

Amory Maynard, for whom the town was named, was born in the Northeast part of Marlboro, at the foot of Fort Meadow Pond, on February 28, 1804. The name of Maynard, however, is found in Sudbury previous to 1646. A John Maynard died there in 1672. His son Zachary, born in 1647, lived at one time in the area. The Maynard family has long been known as among the first settlers of the region.

AMORY MAYNARD'S ACTIVITIES

Amory Maynard saw that something new could be added. There was already a grst mill, operated by water power, which was purchased in 1821 by James and William Rice, which had "previously been owned by one Gibson, and then Jewell". Traces of the Mill Race can still be seen on the Assabet River bridge near Mill Street.

A paper mill was put up by William May in 1820, where paper was made by hand. And, in 1835, powder mills were built on the river, just over the town line in Acton.

When Amory Maynard was 16 years old, his father died, leaving him in charge of a sawmill at Fort Meadow. He was successful at the Sawmill business, and shortly added contracting to his enterprises, presently employing about sixty men.

The Town of Boston took over Fort Meadow Pond for water supply, and Amory's sawmill lost its water rights. It was then that Amory looked toward Assabet Village.

Amory Maynard had come in contact with William Knight during his contracting days, and from this partnership came the project of building a mill on the Assabet River for the manufacture of carpets.



EARLY MILLS

He made his first purchase of land on 19 May, 1846, acquiring land situated on both sides of the River. He continued his purchases until he controlled all available water power rights in the vicinity, and by the month of July, 1846. He owned one hundred and nine acres of land in the heart of Assabet village. In a few years he had acquired water rights up the river to Boon Pond in Stow and to Fort Meadow Pond in Marlborough.

FURTHER PURCHASES

A strip of land was acquired from Haman Smith, from the river to the present Mill Pond to accommodate a canal, and the pond area, then low swampy ground, was cleared. Ben Smith dam was thrown across the river, and water wheels installed. The first small mill, 50 by 100 feet was built, and in 1847, the manufacture of carpet was begun under the name of Assabet Mills.

The mills ran until 1857 when a financial panic closed them, and they were sold at auction.

REORGANIZATION

The mills were reorganized in 1862 with Amory Maynard as agent in time to take advantage of large orders of cloth for the Union Army during the civil war. Carpet manufacture ceased, and blankets were produced, as well as flannels and woolen cloth for uniforms.

The Assabet Mills grew and prospered in up and down cycles, until in 1898 they were the largest woolen mills in the World.

However, difficult times, from 1893 to 1898 had again brought the Mills to insolvency and receivership, following which the property was acquired by the American Woolen Company.

COMMUNITY LOSSES



Unfortunately, the Assabet Mills had also been the financial substitute for a bank in the Community, and when the Mill failed the deposits of both citizens and the town of Maynard went with it. Some recovery was made, although severe losses were sustained by many.

EXPANSION AGAIN

When the American Woolen Manufacturing Company took over the mills they began a program of expansion, replacing old machinery and adding to the already massive collection of buildings. In those days, large employers often built housing for their employees, and many of these units were built in Maynard and subsequently sold to tenants, many of whom were employees of the mill, as the need for this type of housing diminished.

World War I saw a resurgence of multiple-shift operations at the Mill, as again, blankets, woolen cloth for uniforms, etc. were produced for the Army.



ONE-INDUSTRY TOWN

The hazards of being a one-industry town were noted from time to time. The old-time entrepreneurs of Assabet Mills as well as the American Woolen Company did not welcome any competition which might influence their available labor supply. Consequently, in spite of occasional lip-service on behalf of diversification, any real progress toward inviting other business to the community was actually opposed, or effectively torpedoed undercover, by the dominant company.





MAYNARD INDUSTRIES

Maynard ceased to be a one-industry town in 1950, when the American Woolen Company finally relinquished operations and closed the mill.

By July, 1953, several enterprising Worcester business men had bought the huge mill property for an estimated \$200,000.00 and began to seek diversification which had been denied to the community for a hundred years.

COMPUTER

One of the first new enterprises to take space in the old Mill property was the Digital Equipment Corporation. Begun in early 1957 by Ken Olsen, Stan Olsen and Harland Anderson who left M. I. T.'s Lincoln Laboratories to found their own company, Digital has become one of the world's largest manufacturers in its field.

Although there were already many manufacturers producing computers, Digital's improvements and cost-cutting methods has in a few short years made them a leader in the industry. Maynard shares in this company's pride by adopting the title of "The Computer Capitol of the world."

The Company began with only 8500 square feet of space in the Maynard Mill Complex. It was financed by a Boston-based venture capital firm, American Research and Development, which purchased 70% of the company for an initial investment of \$70,000.

Digital pioneered in the field of mini-computers, and proved that there was a market for this type of computer. It is an extremely successful operation.

THE MAYNARD POLICE DEPARTMENT

Fortunately, from the standpoint of the compiler of a souvenir program book such as this, the Maynard Police Department is new enough so that the entire history of the department is available and well documented.

In "A History of Maynard Massachusetts" printed by the town under the auspices of the Maynard Historical Society, is an account which is so well-done that to paraphrase or condense it would detract from the material.

We are sure that the historical Committee will not mind if we therefore quote verbatim from this excellent piece of work, and in passing, offer the comment that this "History of Maynard" is one of the best efforts of its kind we have ever seen, and constitutes a most valuable resource for writers and researchers in the coming years.

From "History of Maynard Massachusetts," page 94. . . .

"One of the first important needs of the town was Police protection, and the citizens at the first town meeting in 1871 elected three constables, Fred Fletcher, William Maxwell, and Thomas Farrell Farrell. The Selectmen were to act as Police Commissioners and appointed eight special policemen: E. L. Stevens, E. F. Tilton, William Taylor, John Hickland, John P. Foster, William F. Wood, William Maynard, and Joseph Valley. The constables were to receive \$10 extra for serving as truant officers.

TOWN LOCKUP

"In May, 1871, the Selectmen were authorized to build a lock-up

and a committee of three was appointed; John K. Harriman, Amory Maynard, and John Fuller, to supervise the building of the same. It was built of brick about fourteen by fourteen feet, containing two cells, at a cost of \$455.70 It was located just off Main Street at the rear of what is now No. 1 Railroad Street. The Selectmen, as Police Commissioners, meticulously reported the cost of the new lockup in the annual Town report.

RISING COSTS -1800's style

By 1876, the cost of Police was \$150 a year, and by 1890 had risen to \$604.15, with three constables and nine special police.

In 1882, two policemen were chosen for night duty and two for duty from twelve noon to midnight, at \$2.25 per day.

In April, 1894, it was voted to build a new lock-up on the Westerly corner of the fire engine house on Nason Street, to be of brick or stone. It was built of Brick, at a cost of \$694.00 (This building is standing today).

From 1894 to 1900 the Department appropriation was \$500 a year. However, with the great increase in population caused by the American Woolen Company expansion of the Mill Complex, 1903 saw an appropriation of \$1700. On October 3, 1902, it was voted that the chairman of the Board of Selectmen was to act as Chief of Police, and John Connors of Marlborough and Samuel G. King were appointed as full-time patrolmen.

COMMUNICATIONS

In 1909 a new safety measure for the populace in reach of a telephone was installed at the corner of Main and Nason streets. It was known as the "Call Light" and anyone desiring an officer

at night could call the telephone operator, who then turned on the light. The officer then learned through the operator, the location of the party calling for him. A rather circuitous method of reaching the police compared with today, but adequate for those days and nights of sixty years ago.

In 1913, Officer Connors was named deputy Chief, and in 1917, patrol boxes for the night patrolmen were installed at a cost of \$500. On February 13, 1924 the Police Department was made a separate department under the direction of the Board of Selectmen and Deputy Connors was made Chief of Police.

AUTOMOBILES

Automobile hire by the department in 1920 came to \$121.00 - no cruisers as yet.

The February 9, 1925 town meeting voted to accept the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 31, Civil Service Act, whereby the Chief of Police and the regular or permanent police force shall be subject to said chapter and rates made thereunder. On February 11, 1925, John Connors was named Chief; Nicholas J. Driscoll Sergeant, Arthur Webber and Harold Hanson, Patrolmen, under Civil Service rules, with the Selectmen retaining direction of the Police Department.

In 1930, life-preservers, ropes, ladders and a boat were placed on the Mill Pond. Crosswalks and yellow lines were painted in various places for the first time for traffic safety, indicating increased automobile traffic. Also in 1930, the Police Headquarters were moved from the Selectmen's office in Creighton's block to Gruber's Block, and in 1934, moved to four rooms fronting Main Street in the west side of the recently acquired "Town Building.

The lockup was moved to this location.

In 1936, John Connors, Chief of Police for thirteen years and with thirty four years on the force died on October 9, and on April 1, 1937, Henry F. Piecewicz was appointed Chief.

The Department received its first cruiser in 1938, and in 1939 a pension system was instituted, with Sergeant Nicholas Driscoll the following year the first to retire under it. The year 1946 saw the installation of the first two-way radio for the cruiser, and in 1950 the one and only traffic light in town was installed at paper mill corner after a traffic survey.

Parking meters were installed in 1951 and the five day week for the Department was passed at the 1953 town meeting.

Chief Piecewicz retired in 1954, and on November 30, 1955, Michael T. Zapareski was appointed Chief.

NEW LOCATION

On October 4, 1955, the Department moved into the new combination Police and Fire station.

Chief Zapareski retired March 1, 1968, and on October 1, 1968 Sergeant Albert J. Crowley was appointed Chief.
