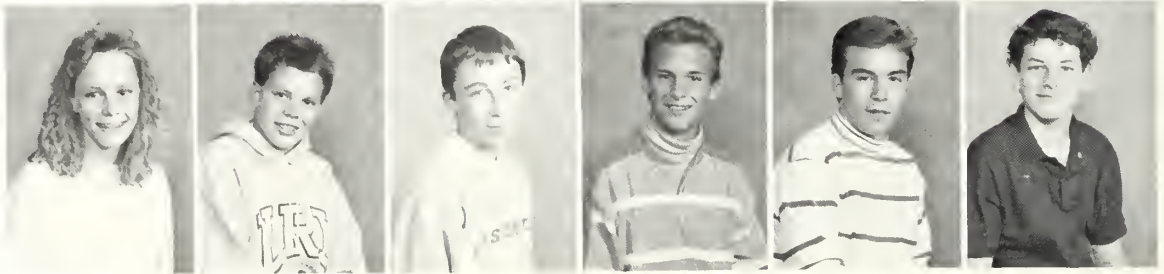
The Class of 1993

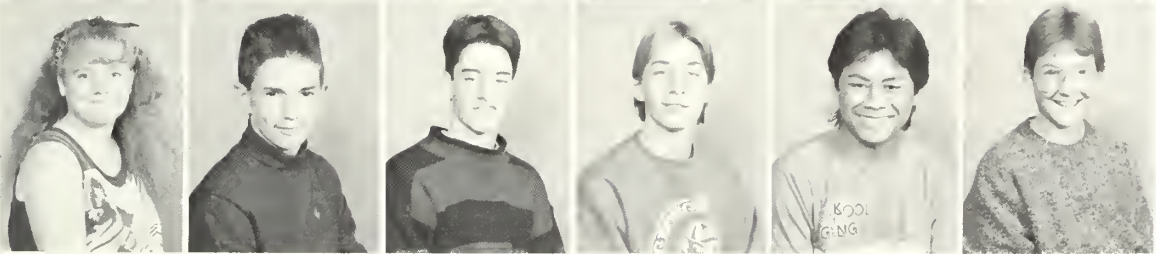

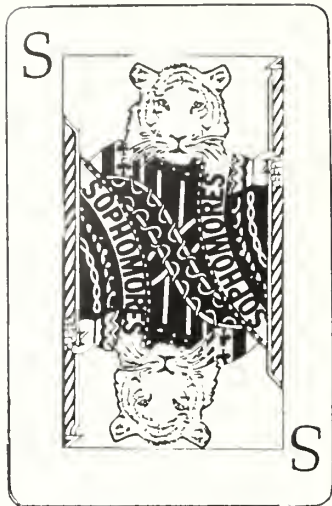

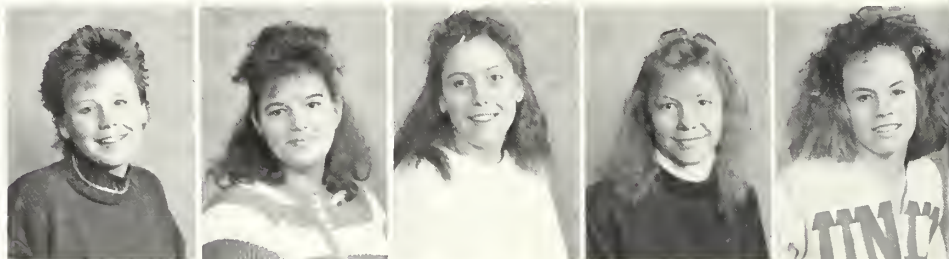




The Class of 1992
