

## MS-Windows course now available

Learning MS-Windows in a PCSA/VAXmate Environment Part No. EY-8265E-PR

This self-paced, text-based course is designed for users of the VAXmate, Digital's desktop workstation. As a networked system, the VAXmate provides direct access to many computer resources through any VAX server. MS-Windows lets users take advantage of these resources. PCSA is an acronym for personal computer system architecture.

The course focuses on practical demonstrations of several MS-Windows applications, such as: MS-Notepad, MS-Clipboard, MS-Paint, VT220 terminal emulator, and Control Panel. A course that can be used in the PC environment is also available.

## Dennis Simonaitis wins Corporate Challenge World Championships

Dennis Simonaitis, Customer Service representative at the Customer Returns Center in Woburn, has won the prestigious Manufacturer's Hanover Corporate Challenge World Championships in New York City. Dennis covered the 3.5 mile course in a time of 16 minutes, 17 seconds to lead a field of more than 2,000 corporate runners from 16 cities around the world.

Runners competing in this event represented the fastest of more than 80,000 corporate runners who had competed in regional events throughout the year. Dennis qualified for the finals by winning the Boston Manufacturer's Hanover Race last July.

The Digital men's team, which won the Boston men's title, finished fourth out of 18 teams. All of the Digital runners finished in the top 85. Competing for Digital on the men's team in addition to Dennis were: Kevin Larue (HLO), 17:08; Lance Burgess (MKO), 17:16; Roger Nasatka (WMO),

18:04; and Bruce Labonte (WMO), 18:08.

Dennis, Kevin, Roger and Bruce and other Digital runners will compete in the U.S. Corporate Marathon Championships on Jan. 17 in Houston. Dennis, who will be running his first marathon, will try to qualify for the U.S. Olympic Marathon Trials by running faster than two hours. 20 minutes.

## 1987-88 flu season update

(The following article was prepared by Health Services.)

You felt fine at noon, but by 3 p.m. your head is throbbing and your muscles ache. By bedtime, you're running a temperature and your throat is so sore you can barely swallow. Is it the flu, or is it just a bad cold?

It's probably the flu. Flu, or influenza, is a viral infection of the upper respiratory tract which can be distinguished from the common cold by its symptoms. It starts abruptly, frequently with high fever, a dry cough, headache, muscle pain, and a generally unwell feeling. Most people recover completely within a week or two.

Flu occurs worldwide during the winter months. Widespread outbreaks of flu usually begin in December in the United States, reach a peak in January and February, and may continue into the spring. This winter, it's expected that flu strains will be closely related to Type A/Taiwan, Type A/Leningrad, and Type B/Ann Arbor.

Why are so many people stricken with influenza in the winter? As temperatures drop, people stay inside more, increasing their risk of being exposed to viruses. In addition, cold weather dries out the mucuous membranes, especially in the nose and throat, making them more susceptible to infection.

A bout with the flu can lower resistance to

other diseases, especially certain bacterial infections and pneumonia. For that reason, the U.S. Public Health Service recommends flu vaccines for high-risk individuals: adults and children with chronic lung, heart, or kidney disease, diabetes mellitus, severe anemia, or inadequate immune systems, and for everyone 65 years of age or older. The USPHS also advises the vaccine for families and household contacts of people in the high-risk group. People who are highly allergic to eggs and those with acute febrile illnesses should not be vaccinated.

Although the current influenza vaccine often contains one or more antigens used in previous years, immunity declines in the year following vaccination. For maximum protection against the flu, those who received the 1986-87 vaccine should be revaccinated this year. Digital's Health Services departments don't give flu vaccines. But Health Services urges employees who are in one of the high-risk groups to contact their physician about receiving a flu shot.

Bed rest, plenty of fluids, and analgesics such as aspirin and acetaminophen will help relieve flu symptoms. For more information about the flu, contact your local Health Services office, or your health care provider.

"This facility will be the world hub for all of Digital's manufacturing work in the research and development of printed circuit boards," says John Caulfield, Greenville site manager. "The facility will enhance our competitive advantage in manufacturing, and assist us in reaching our customer satisfaction goals."

The R&D Center will develop processes and strategies to ensure that future new products can be built using state-of-the-art technology. Says John, "We'll also work with vendors who supply specific pieces of equipment to develop capabilities that can't be bought 'off the shelf' today."

Rod Schmidt, group manager of the Printed Wiring Board organization in Westford, adds that the new facility will improve the company's time-to-market competitiveness. "When you're developing and intro-

ducing high-tech manufacturing processes, it's absolutely critical to combine the development of the process with the volume manufacturing of the product," he says. "Centralizing our development and manufacturing resources will help us to be just that much more efficient."

The Greenville plant, a 200,000-square-foot facility, currently employs about 950 people. The research center will add about 100,000 square feet, along with another 200 highly skilled jobs in the printed circuit industry. The project is expected to be completed in early 1989. ■

## Revised W-2 form more detailed

Each year, the Corporate Payroll Department receives hundreds of questions concerning employee W-2 forms. The 1987 W-2 form has been redesigned to provide additional information that will help answer most of these questions.

For example, the revised form will break out forms of compensation such as non-cash prizes and awards, relocation compensation, and miscellaneous forms of compensation such as long-term disability payments received. And finally, a more detailed Box 10

reconciles an employee's year-to-date adjusted gross earnings plus additional compensation not recorded on the final pay stub to total wages and other compensation recorded in Box 10.
