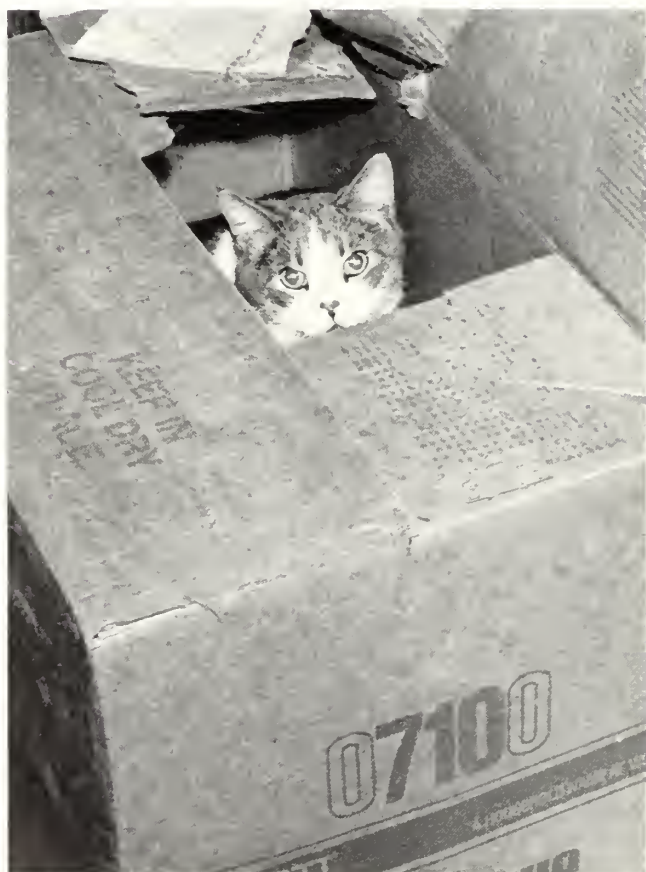
The 1987 Yearbook Staff
