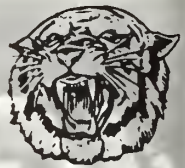


Dear 2008 Maynard Football Players,

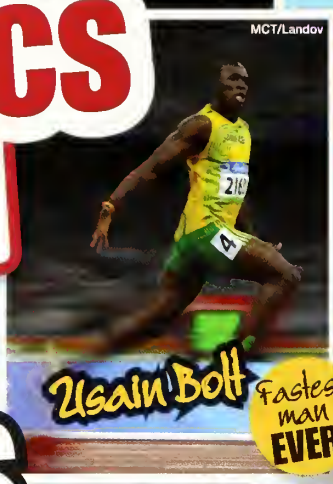
