## Morse wins engineering fellowship

Mill employee John Morse is recipient of the 1980-81 Digital Engineering Fellowship, offered annually to a hardware or software engineer who has made significant technological contributions to the company.

A principal engineer for the Corporate Research group, John has worked extensively on software development systems and emulators. He has also served as performance analysis consultant for the Data Base Management System-11 and the IAS operating system.

John will spend one academic year at the University of Connecticut to begin work on a Ph.D. in electrical engineering and computer science. He plans to specialize in the area of software engineering and distributed operating systems design, tying his studies into an ongoing project at Corporate Research.

## New systems join MINC family

The MINC family of laboratory computer systems has three new members that offer twice the processor speed and four times the memory capacity of older models, according to an announcement by Marlboro's Laboratory Data Products (LDP) group.

The new systems, using a PDP-11/23 processor, are MINC-23, MINC/DECLAB23-RT and MINC/DECLAB23-RSX.

A MINC system can be tailored to the specific needs of a customer, either as a stand-alone system, or net-

worked with other Digital computers operating under DECnet.

The MINC-23 is a portable system with diskette storage; the MINC/DECLAB23-RT uses dual five- or 10-megabyte disk cartridges; and the MINC/DECLAB23-RSX uses the RSX-11M multiuser, multitasking operating system. All three systems have full floating-point functions. Prices are \$15,600, \$23,300 and \$30,300, respectively.

Deliveries are scheduled to begin in December.

Each year, a winner is selected by a committee of five consulting engineers named by Gordon Bell, Vice President, Engineering, and Jim Bell, manager, Research and Development.

Candidates, who must work for Digital at least five years, are judged on their contributions to the company, how their program of study would benefit Digital as well as their own careers, level of teaching and com-

munication skills, and whether their absence would jeopardize a committed project.

John joined Digital in 1976 as a senior analyst and programmer for the Typeset Software Development group. The following year he joined the Corporate Research group.

In 1977, he began teaching graduate courses in the theory and practice of compiler design at both Lowell University and Boston University.
