a total of \$981.75 for 1050 feet, the smallest amount that could be put in with satisfactory results. This would leave but a small margin of the appropriation for labor. In view of these facts we thought best to leave the matter with the town for any further action it might take.

Our financial report shows an expenditure on account of poor in hospitals and asylums of \$1101.34, leaving a balance of \$1959.79 paid for home poor, an increase of between \$300 and \$400 over last year, notwithstanding four have died within the year, who were fully supported, and three who were receiving partial support. We are inclined to believe that a small farm on which the town could keep its poor would be economy.

There has been a considerable amount of money expended in and around Glenwood Cemetery during the past year, and we are satisfied that it was money well spent. A substantial stone wall has been laid around the old Turnpike school grounds, enclosing them with the cemetery proper, thus enlarging and improving the appearance of the cemetery and surroundings. In the yard wheel guards have been set at all corners where the avenues intersect, thereby protecting the edges and banks of corner lots. The Public Statutes provide that the income from cemeteries shall be expended on the same. We are gratified to know that there is a small amount in favor of the cemetery, notwithstanding the extensive improvements of the past year.

Our highways have been well looked after, and some extensive and much needed improvements made. Owing to numerous wash-outs during the summer, surveyor Whitney felt obliged to overdraw on his appropriation, which he did to the amount of 106.11. We congratulate ourselves that we have a good return for the money expended. Beside extensive repairs in grading, like those on Acton street and the Stow road, there have been 410 feet of curb stone laid on Main street, costing about \$200.00. We think this a move in the right direction, as curb stone gives a look of solidity to the street, and when once laid insures an excellent thoroughfare without necessitating continual repairs.

Our financial report shows an expenditure of \$3,058.75, or \$58.75 more than the appropriation. Of this amount \$90.10 is due from the Commonwealth for support of state poor and \$22.00 from the town of Acton, for aid to Hannah Trainer. Our list of poor has considerably increased during the year. John Callahan and wife have been added as full support paupers, Michael Noonan for temporary support, Bridget Greeley is receiving partial support and Catherine Flynn has been aided a portion of the year. Daniel Warren was committed to the Worcester Insane Asylum last June and has since died. Other deaths that have occurred, are Julia Buckley at Worcester and Robert Gregg at Tewksbury Almshouse. We still believe in the almshouse theory that a small farm outside the village, where our poor could be maintained, and the able bodied found in employment would result advantageously to our finances, their moral condition would be benefited thereby and that pauperism would increase less rapidly in the town.
