REPORT OF 1963 and 1964 GIRL SCOUT FUND RAISING IN MAYNARD

1963 Program of Children's Movie was set up by Mrs. Jane Nagle, Fund Raising Director of Bay Path Colonial Girl Scout Council.
Date December 29 at Fine Arts Theatre, two shows 1:00 P.M. and 3:00 P.M. with cartoons and Fleepo the Clown in person. Each show lasted 1 1/2 hours. 50¢ admission charge for anyone, children did not have to be accompanied by adult.

1964 A decision to change from cartoons was made by the Committee and Betty Blair, Jane Nagle's successor in Bay Path Colonial Girl Scout Council.
"Seven Voyages of Sinbad" was selected to be shown on Sunday, November 29 at the Fine Arts Theatre with two shows 1:00 P.M. and 3:00 P.M. A short cartoon was also shown with it. Tickets were 50¢ for anyone.
No candy was sold either year. On Sunday November 29, 1964 at 12:40 P.M. Jack Grieve called chairman to inform her that the wrong film was delivered at 12:30. It was "Jason and the Argonauts". What else was there to do but run the wrong film? Jack Grieve had rented the films for us both years and worked the projector.
Six Cadettes were usheretts at each show with about five leaders or other adults supervising them in case of any trouble. Attendance at the two shows was 751 as compared with 476 in 1963. Capacity of the theatre is 400.

Tickets were sold at window in 1963 by Betty Musgrave; in 1964 by Ann Maglione and Madeline Benedict. Charlie Groves, manager of the theatre was on duty from noon until the end both years. We could never have had two good years without his services. Civil Defense police were on duty both years.

Tickets were printed by Murphy-Snyder and passed out to leaders, about 3 or 4 weeks in advance of show. Mothers were expected to sell six tickets. Posters were made by any good helpers. Letters and fliers were mimeographed by the Council Office. Newspapers and local radio stations were notified.

Selectman Albert Alexanian has been chairman of sponsors for these two years and has done a fine job. He signed 108 letters that were sent to business men and industries in the town. These letters were mailed about three weeks before movie date, asking for donations to support Girl Scouting in Maynard.

Checks payable to the Council were sent to all in care of the Town House.

Thank you notes were sent later.
