## He helps those in need - quietly

Good Samaritans seem a little hard to find these days, especially along those barren stretches of interstate highway. Occasionally though, some-

one does something that restores your faith in human nature.

Dave Ostertag is one of those people. Dave drives one of Digital's "big rigs"

at night, alternating between Northboro and Burlington, Vermont and Northboro and Augusta, Maine.

On his way back from Burlington, along Interstate 89 near Waterbury, Vermont, Dave saw a mobile home about a quarter of a mile from the highway explode into flame.

Using his C.B., he notified the driver behind him that he was going to stop and help, and asked the driver to inform the State Police of the situation.

Dave got out of his truck, ran down the embankment, leaped over a wire fence and got the occupants of the flaming trailer out - with nothing but the clothes they had on.

He also alerted the occupant of the adjacent mobile home of the fire and got him out safely.

The fire department arrived to find the trailer completely consumed. However, it was able to keep the bottled gas from exploding and the other trailer from catching fire.

Dave left, taking his rig back to Northboro without a word to anyone about his act of heroism.

Dave's supervisor Bill Franklin recently received a card: "To whom it may concern" from the truck driver who alerted the State Police about the fire. The card read, "On Saturday, April 14, I observed a driver conduct himself in an exemplary manner. Discovering a mobile home on fire and disregarding his own personal safety, he roused residents both close by and in the flaming house, thus averting serious injury or loss of life." The driver had the license plate num-

# Student Loan Program available

Is your son or daughter starting college this fall? If so, you may be faced with the highest tuition bills in history. In order to assist you in meeting spiraling education costs, Digital has announced a new benefit -- a Student Loan Program.

The program makes low-cost, deferred re-payment loans available to all employees, their spouses and their dependent children. Loans may be obtained by any full-time or permanent part-time employee (at least 30 hours) with two years continuous service, or by any retirees with five years continuous service.

Unlike Student Loan Programs through private lending institutions, there is no income restriction or credit check. Administrative costs are paid by Digital, not the student and a co-signer is not necessary.

Under the Student Loan Program, Digital has deposited reserves with the United Student Aid Fund, Inc., (USAF) a private, non-profit corporation. USAF in turn guarantees loans to the lender,

the Chase Manhattan Bank. Chase Manhattan makes loans for most two and four year colleges and universities, graduate and professional schools and many vocational schools.

Up to \$2,500 a year may be borrowed for undergraduate studies, to a maximum of \$7,500. Up to \$5,000 a year may be borrowed for graduate studies. A maximum of \$15,000 is allowed for combined undergraduate and graduate studies. The amount of each loan is determined by the borrower, the school and the lender. In any case a loan cannot exceed the actual cost of education.

Pay-back begins 11 months following graduation or termination of studies at a rate of seven percent simple interest. No interest is accumulated while the student is in school. Repayment may take up to 10 years.

In addition to dependent children and spouses, employees planning to take an educational leave of absence may take advantage of this benefit. Employees with two years continuous service may apply for an educational leave of absence. Employees on an educational leave of absence are not eligible for the Tuition Reimbursement Plan.

Also, part-time or half-time students are eligible for this program. They must be accumulating at least six credits or the equivalent.

More information about the Student Loan Program and applications for the coming fall semester are available at your local Personnel Office. A minimum of six weeks lead time should be allowed for processing and approving a loan application.
